April 28, 2015 – Bang-account End-of-Life Dates Approaching

In May 2014 ITS announced the start of a year-long phase-out of bang-accounts in Active Directory. See:

Since that time ITS has issued several reminders via email to the major support lists, email targeted directly to the areas using bang-accounts, and announcements in the WinAdmin and CCSG meetings. At the April 28, 2015 CCSG meeting a schedule was announced for the final end-of-life process as follows:

- June 1, 2015 All existing bang-accounts will be disabled.
- July 1, 2015 All bang-accounts will be moved to a container outside an OU manager's control and disabled.
- August 3, 2015 All bang-accounts will be deleted.

Since January 1, 2015 any OU manager creating a bang-account (or enabling an existing disabled bang-account) has been contacted and instructed to convert to using regular (registered) Net-IDs.

ASW can be used to convert existing bang-accounts to sponsored Net-IDs:

Campus IT Staff Administrative Functions -> Manage Users -> Convert an AD-only bang-user to a Net-ID

This action must be performed by an OU manger with rights to the bang-account. A conversion done in this way is a "rename" to a centrally provisioned Net-ID so the account retains its unique identity used for group memberships, access control, etc.
